



### **Colonel Michael T. McTigue**

Colonel Michael T. McTigue was commissioned as an Adjutant General Corps Officer after his graduation from the United States Military Academy in 1994 with a Bachelor of Science degree in Mechanical Engineering (Aerospace). A native of North Olmsted, Ohio, his career spans more than 24 years and he has served in a variety of command and staff assignments in the United States, Germany, Kosovo, and Iraq.

Command assignments include Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 516<sup>th</sup> Signal Brigade in Fort Shafter, Hawaii; C Detachment, 38<sup>th</sup> Personnel Services Battalion in Ansbach, Germany; Task Force 38<sup>th</sup> Personnel Services Battalion in Kosovo during Operation Joint Guardian; 120<sup>th</sup> Adjutant General Battalion (Reception) at Fort Jackson, South Carolina; and U.S. Army 3<sup>rd</sup> Recruiting Brigade in Fort Knox, Kentucky where he was responsible for recruiting operations and over 2,200 personnel across 17 mid-west states.

Colonel McTigue is a graduate of the Adjutant General Officer Basic and Advanced courses, the Combined Arms Services and Staff School, the U.S. Army Command and General Staff College, the Joint and Combined Warfighting School, and the U.S. Army War College where he completed a fellowship assigned to Honeywell International in Tempe, Arizona as part of the Secretary of Defense Corporate Fellows Program.
