## **CW5 DAVID G. BETANCOURT** **Chief Warrant Officer of the Corps**

CW5 Betancourt was born in Manhattan, New York and raised in San Juan, Puerto Rico. He graduated from the University of Puerto Rico, San Juan in 1985 and entered the Army in 1992 as a 75F. CW5 Betancourt attended Warrant Officer Candidate School in 1999 and his first duty assignment was with the Alpha Detachment, 203rd Personnel Services Battalion, Fort Wainwright, Alaska, where he served as the Military Personnel Officer.

In 2002, CW5 Betancourt served as the Deputy G1/AG for the Combined Arms Center and Fort Leavenworth, Kansas, where he served as the Acting G1/AG and later as the Deputy SGS. In 2005, CW5 Betancourt served as the S1, Military Personnel Officer for the 5th Special Forces Group (Airborne), Fort Campbell, Kentucky, where he deployed twice to Iraq in support of Operation IRAQI FREEDOM. In 2007, CW5 Betancourt attended Airborne school and, afterwards, was selected as the Forces Command Liaison to the Human Resources Command, Alexandria, Virginia. He served as the FORSCOM G1, Strength Management Division LNO, as well as the G1s liaison to HQDA G1 and G3 at the Pentagon. In 2010, CW5 Betancourt served as the Chief, Army Branch for the United States Special Operations Command (USSOCOM), MacDill Air Force Base, Florida. In May 2012, CW5 Betancourt deployed again and served as the Human Resources Military Assistant to the Commander, International Security Assistance Force/United States Forces-Afghanistan. In 2013, after redeployment, CW5 Betancourt volunteered to support the Special Operations Command Central J1, where he served as the J1 Personnel Officer. In 2014, CW5 Betancourt was selected as the Senior Human Resources Technician for III Corps & Ft Hood G1 where he manages the HR Warrant Officer population for all III Corps organizations encompassing Fort Hood, Fort Bliss, Fort Carson and Fort Riley.

CW5 Betancourt holds a Bachelor's degree in Computer Information Systems, and a Master's Degree in Computer Resources and Information Management. His military education includes the Warrant Officer Basic and Advanced Courses, the Warrant Officer Staff Course, the Warrant Officer Senior Staff Course, and Airborne School.
