Subj: MARINE STUDENT UNIFORM LIST

1. Marine student personnel must have at a minimum the following uniform items:

- a. Desert Combat Utility Uniforms
- b. Woodland Combat Utility Uniforms
- c. Service 'A', 'B', 'C' Uniforms
- d. Combat Boots
- e. Marine Corps Running Suit
- f. Marine Corps Sweat Top and Bottom
- g. Multiple Green Skivy Shirts
- h. Marine Corps All Weather Coat
- i. Wooly Pooly (green)
- j. Green PT Shorts With Glow Belt
- k. Running Shoes

2. Uniform items must be serviceable for wear. The combat utility uniform may be used for physical training as required.

3. Entry level Marine F5 Postal Operations student personnel reporting in from Marine Combat Training will wear the Service Alpha Uniform.

4. Marine students that are TAD attending the F4 Postal Supervisors Course will report in the prescribed combat utility uniform and will not need their Service 'A' uniform.

5. Graduation uniforms will be in the prescribed combat utility uniform. The combat utility uniform will be the uniform of the day Monday thru Friday. The Service 'C' or 'B' uniform will be worn the first Friday of every month unless otherwise dictated by the Director of the Inter-service Postal School.
