CW5 Chad G. Bowen was born and raised in Dayton, Ohio. He enlisted in 1991 in the United States Army Reserves as a Technical Draftsman (81B), completing basic training and AIT at Fort Leavenworth, Kansas. Only a few months later, he joined the Active Army, reclassing to 75F, Personnel Information Systems Management Specialist. He completed his AIT at Fort Benjamin Harrison, Indiana in 1992. After assignments to Fort Bragg, NC, Fort Lewis, WA, Fort Campbell, KY, Fort Jackson, SC, and Camp Stanley, Korea, he was appointed as a Warrant Officer in December 2004.

CW5 Bowen most recently served as the V Corps Senior HR Technician, Fort Knox, KY. CW5 Bowen deployed in support of contingencies to Operation Iraqi Freedom (OIF) in 2006.

CW5 Bowen is a graduate of the Warrant Officer Senior Service Education, Warrant Officer Staff Course, Adjutant General Corps Warrant Officer Advanced and Basic Courses, Adjutant General's Corps Advanced and Basic Noncommissioned Officer Courses, and the Primary Leadership Development Course.
