Subj: MARINE STUDENT UNIFORM LIST

1. Marine students attending training at the Interservice Postal Training Activity (IPTA) will bring the uniform items listed below to training unless otherwise directed by IPTA personnel. All Uniform items must be serviceable for wear.

- a. Woodland Marine Corps Combat Utility Uniforms (MCCUU)
- b. Service 'A', 'B', 'C' Uniforms
- c. Combat Boots
- d. Marine Corps Running Suit
- e. Marine Corps Sweat Top and Bottom
- f. Green Undershirts
- g. Green PT Shorts
- h. Reflective PT Belt
- i. Marine Corps All Weather Coat
- j. Green Service Sweater with Epaulettes
- k. Running Shoes

2. The Woodland MCCUU will be the uniform of the day for classroom instruction and graduations, Monday through Friday, unless otherwise directed by the IPTA staff.

3. Entry level Marine students reporting from Marine Combat Training or other schools will report in the Service Alpha Uniform for the first training day.

4. Marine students TAD to the F4 Postal Supervisor Course will report in the Woodland MCCUU and will not be required to bring the Service 'A' uniform. Postal Supervisor Course students will bring their seasonal Service 'B' or 'C' uniform for designated class events.

5. All Marine students will bring PT uniforms. The MCCUU may be used for physical training as required.
